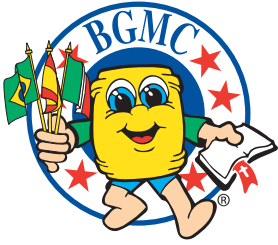


2017-2018 BGMC Missions Summits
